11.	M1U11	a small round piece of metal, usually silver, copper or gold coloured, which is used as money	That Coca machine doesn't take 50p <b>11.</b> .
12.	M1U12	to win or get a point, goal, etc. in a competitive activity, such as a sport or game	You <b>12.</b> a goal in the last minute of the match. That's great!
