Exam Tips!

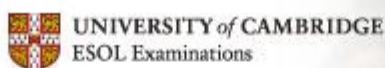
What do I have to do?

How do I do it?

- ✓ Find the important words in the question. Then look for words with similar meaning in the notices.
- ✓ Think about the meaning of the notices. You shouldn't choose a notice just because it uses the same word or number as the question.
- ✓ Remember, you can't use the notice that was used in the example.
