In the spring of 2000 a group of Americans were climbing the north side of Everest, the highest mountain in the world. They were getting to the top when one of them saw something in the ice. It was a body under the snow. The man was wearing leather shoes and old-fashioned clothes made of wool. They were probably very warm, but they weren't as good as the clothes climbers wear today. Inside his jacket there was a name: George Leigh Mallory.

George Leigh Mallory was a famous British climber in the 1920s. In 1924 he went to the Himalayas with his friend Andrew Irvine. They wanted to be the first people to climb Everest. But something went wrong. Perhaps he or Irvine fell. Perhaps the weather changed suddenly and they froze to death. Nobody knows.

But there is another mystery in this story. The body was only 600 meters from the top of the mountain. Did Mallory die before he got to the top of the mountain, or after? Was Edmund Hillary really the first to climb Everest, in 1953? Or did Mallory and Irvine get there first, 25 years before?
